## Subject : Verizon Partner Solutions Industry Letter: Tewksbury MA DMS100 Switch Retirement

### PLEASE NOTE:

All references to the Tewksbury MA DMS100 switch are associated with CLLI code **TWBYMARODS1** and will not be repeated throughout this letter. All references to the Lowell MA Packet End Office (PEO) switch are associated with CLLI code **LWLLMAAPPSA** and will not be repeated throughout this letter.

As set out in the Verizon New England Inc. Short Term Public Notice Under Rule 51.333(a), dated June 3, 2026, the Tewksbury MA DMS100 switch will be retired and removed from the Verizon network on or after July 29, 2026, as part of ongoing efforts to modernize the network.

**General Information:** The Exchange Codes (NXXs) in Numbering Plan Area (NPA) 978 currently residing in the Tewksbury MA DMS100 switch (see list in Table B below) will be moved to the Lowell MA PEO switch (see details in Table A below). The native NPA NXXs belonging to the Tewksbury MA DMS100 switch will be rehomed upon decommissioning of the switch and reflected in the Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) for the Lowell MA PEO switch. This will occur on or after July 29, 2026.

### Network Changes and Trunk Rearrangements:

The Lowell MA PEO switch will be the recipient office of traffic migrated from the Tewksbury MA DMS100 switch. Traffic bound for the codes listed in Table B will be delivered via the Lawrence MA Tandem (LWRNMACA03T intra-Lata SHA / LWRNMACA03T inter-Lata FG Access SHA).

After all traffic is migrated off of the Tewksbury MA DMS100 switch, it will be retired and removed from the network.

CLECs, IXCs, IECs, wireless carriers, and paging carriers will need to secure new trunk groups built to the Lowell MA PEO switch or have existing trunk groups to that switch augmented. Carriers that have direct end office trunks (DEOT) with access connectivity in the Tewksbury MA DMS100 switch will be required to reposition the codes to the Lowell MA PEO switch.

All ASRs for the Lowell MA PEO switch must be received no later than July 1, 2026, to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. All traffic must be moved by July 29, 2026.

Please adhere to industry standards using normal procedures that pertain to updates and changes to the LERG for all NXXs subject to the retirement of the Tewksbury MA DMS100 switch.
