PLEASE NOTE:

- All references to the Fitchburg MA DMS100 switch are associated with CLI code FTBGMAMADS1 and will not be repeated throughout this notice.
- All references to the Newton MA C20 switch are associated with CLI code NWTNMAWAPS1 and will not be repeated throughout this notice.

Description of the Planned Network Change(s):

The Verizon Fitchburg MA DMS100 switch, located at 676 Main Street, Fitchburg, MA 01420, will be retired and removed from the network after all traffic served by this switch is migrated to the Verizon Newton MA C20 switch, located at 787 Washington Street, Newton, MA 02460. All traffic to be migrated includes, but is not limited to, Inter-LATA (ACCESS/FG-B-D/CLEC/IXC), wireless, and paging traffic.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact(s) of the Planned Change(s):

Competitive local exchange carriers (CLECs), interexchange carriers (IXCs, IECs), wireless carriers, and paging carriers will need to secure new trunk groups built to the Newton MA C20 switch or have existing trunk groups to that switch augmented. Carriers that are code holders for access connectivity in the Fitchburg MA DMS100 switch will be required to reposition the codes to the Newton MA C20 switch.

All ASRs for the Newton MA C20 switch must be received no later than August 15, 2025, to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. These direct end office trunk (DEOT) interconnections will support traffic migration for the Fitchburg MA DMS100 switch prior to its eventual decommissioning. Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) change effective dates will be posted prior to decommissioning of the Fitchburg MA DMS100 switch (**on or after October 1, 2025**). This will serve to guide interconnect re-routes of traffic for the seven (7) native codes currently served by the Fitchburg MA DMS100 switch to reflect the Newton MA C20 switch as the new home switch.
