PLEASE NOTE:

- All references to the Buffalo Hertel NY DMS100 switch are associated with CLI code BFLONYHEDS0 and will not be repeated throughout this notice.
- All references to the Buffalo NY Packet End Office (PEO) switch are associated with CLI code BFLONYFRPS0 and will not be repeated throughout this notice.

Description of the Planned Network Change(s):

The Verizon Buffalo Hertel NY DMS100 switch, located at 935 Hertel Avenue, Buffalo, NY 14216, will be retired and removed from the network after all traffic served by this switch is migrated to the Verizon Buffalo NY PEO switch, located at 65 Franklin Street, Buffalo, NY 14202. All traffic to be migrated includes, but is not limited to, Inter-LATA (ACCESS/FG-B-D/CLEC/IXC), wireless, and paging traffic.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact(s) of the Planned Change(s):

Competitive local exchange carriers (CLECs), interexchange carriers (IXCs, IECs), wireless carriers, and paging carriers will need to secure new trunk groups built to the Buffalo NY PEO switch or have existing trunk groups to that switch augmented. Carriers that are code holders for access connectivity in the Buffalo Hertel NY DMS100 switch will be required to reposition the codes to the Buffalo NY PEO switch.

All ASRs for the Buffalo NY PEO switch must be received no later than August 15, 2025, to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. These direct end office trunk (DEOT) interconnections will support traffic migration for the Buffalo Hertel NY DMS100 switch prior to its eventual decommissioning. Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) change effective dates will be posted prior to decommissioning of the Buffalo Hertel NY DMS100 switch (**on or after October 1, 2025**). This will serve to guide interconnect re-routes of traffic for the ten (10) native codes currently served by the Buffalo Hertel NY DMS100 switch to reflect the Buffalo NY PEO switch as the new home switch.
