PLEASE NOTE:

- All references to the Plaza Trail VA 5ESS switch are associated with CLI code VRBHVAPTDS0 and will not be repeated throughout the notice.
- All references to the Chinese Corner VA CS2K switch are associated with CLI code VRBHVACCPS0 and will not be repeated throughout the notice.

Description of the Planned Network Change(s):

The Verizon Plaza Trail VA 5ESS switch, located at 132 South Plaza Trail, Virginia Beach, VA 23452, will be retired and removed from the Verizon network after all traffic served by this switch is migrated to the Verizon Chinese Corner VA CS2K switch, located at 221 Dorset Avenue, Virginia Beach, VA 23462. All traffic to be migrated to the Chinese Corner VA CS2K switch includes, but is not limited to, Inter-LATA (ACCESS/FG-B-D/CLEC IXC), wireless and paging traffic.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact(s) of the Planned Change(s):

All carriers—including competitive local exchange carriers (CLECs), Interexchange carriers (IXCs, IECs), wireless carriers, and paging carriers—will need to provision new trunk groups to support direct end office trunking to the Chinese Corner VA CS2K switch or have existing trunk groups to that switch augmented.

All ASRs for the Chinese Corner VA CS2K must be received no later than **April 8, 2026**, to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) change effective dates will be posted prior to decommissioning of the Plaza Trail VA 5ESS switch (**on or after April 30, 2026**). This will serve to guide interconnect re-routes of traffic for the seven (7) native codes currently served by the Plaza Trail VA 5ESS switch to reflect the Chinese Corner VA CS2K switch as the new home switch. All trunks to the Chinese Corner VA CS2K switch must be in place prior to the decommissioning of the Plaza Trail VA 5ESS switch.
