PLEASE NOTE:

All references to the Tewksbury MA DMS100 switch are associated with CLLI code TWBYMARODS1 and will not be repeated throughout this notice.

All references to the Lowell MA PEO switch are associated with CLLI code LWLLMAAPPSA and will not be repeated throughout this notice.

Description of the Planned Network Change(s):

The Verizon Tewksbury MA DMS100 switch, located at 6 Robinson Avenue, Tewksbury, MA 01876, will be retired and removed from the network after all traffic served by this switch is migrated to the Verizon Lowell MA PEO switch, located at 115 Appleton Street, Lowell, MA 01852. All traffic to be migrated includes, but is not limited to, Inter-LATA (ACCESS/FG-B-D/CLEC/IXC), wireless, and paging traffic.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact(s) of the Planned Change(s):

Competitive local exchange carriers (CLECs), interexchange carriers (IXCs, IECs), wireless carriers, and paging carriers will need to secure new trunk groups built to the Lowell MA PEO switch or have existing trunk groups to that switch augmented. Carriers that are code holders for access connectivity in the Tewksbury MA DMS100 switch will be required to reposition the codes to the Lowell MA PEO switch.

All ASRs for the Lowell MA PEO switch must be received no later than July 1, 2026, to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. These direct end office trunk (DEOT) interconnections will support traffic migration for the Tewksbury MA DMS100 switch prior to its eventual decommissioning. Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) change effective dates will be posted prior to decommissioning of the Tewksbury MA DMS100 switch (**on or after July 29, 2026**). This will serve to guide interconnect re-routes of traffic for the four (4) native codes currently served by the Tewksbury MA DMS100 switch to reflect the Lowell MA PEO switch as the new home switch.
