PLEASE NOTE:

All references to the Ashton, RI DMS100 switch are associated with CLLI code ASTNRIANDS1 and will not be repeated throughout this notice.

All references to the Providence, RI C20 switch are associated with CLLI code PRVDRIWAPS1 and will not be repeated throughout this notice.

Description of the Planned Network Change(s):

The Verizon Ashton RI DMS100 switch, located at 25 Angell Road, Ashton, RI 02911, will be retired and removed from the network after all traffic served by this switch is migrated to the Verizon Providence RI C20 switch, located at 234 Washington Street, Providence, RI 02865. All traffic to be migrated includes, but is not limited to Inter-LATA (ACCESS/FG-B-D/CLEC/IXC), wireless, and paging traffic.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact(s) of the Planned Change(s):

Competitive local exchange carriers (CLECs), interexchange carriers (IXCs, IECs), wireless carriers, and paging carriers will need to secure new trunk groups built to the Providence RI C20 switch or have existing trunk groups to that switch augmented. Carriers that are code holders for access connectivity in the Ashton RI DMS100 switch will be required to reposition the codes to the Providence RI C20 switch.

All ASRs for the Providence RI C20 switch must be received no later than July 1, 2026, to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. These direct end office trunk (DEOT) interconnections will support traffic migration for the Ashton RI DMS100 switch prior to its eventual decommissioning. Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) change effective dates will be posted prior to decommissioning of the Ashton RI DMS100 switch (**on or after July 29, 2026**). This will serve to guide interconnect re-routes of traffic for the three (3) native codes currently served by the Ashton RI DMS100 switch to reflect the Providence RI C20 switch as the new home switch.
