July 2026 Release Notification

The upcoming release upgrade for the Verizon Partner Solutions Exchange platform is scheduled for the weekend of Friday, July 17, through Sunday, July 19, 2026, and will feature the following:

Fiber To The Internet (FTTI) Updates:

- All FTTI functionality from Local Service Interface (LSI) is available in the Exchange Platform; therefore FTTI will no longer be available in LSI after this release.
- The FTTI Service Availability screen will feature a new message when FTTI Available is 'No' but the address/building can support FTTI. This message will remind users to adjust the sub-location entered or request a new sub-location be added.

Ordering Due Date Display Changes:

For new orders submitted after this release, the Due Date on the Milestone Summary Screen will no longer be populated with the Desired Due Date and will remain blank until the Committed Due Date is received via the Firm Order Confirmation (FOC). Also, Due Date modifications resulting from a Supp order will be marked by an on-screen indicator.

Ethernet Switched E-Line+ Ranged VLAN:

Ranged VLAN will be offered as an EVC format option when ordering the Switched Eline product on the iEN network.

Product Grandfathering:

Verizon Partner Solutions is grandfathering the Dedicated E-Line and Internet Dedicated Ethernet products. Therefore, Exchange will no longer support quoting and ordering of all speeds and terms for these product sets via both the UI and API. They are referenced by the following Product Offering names under Internet Dedicated Services:

- Dedicated E-Line
- Internet Dedicated Ethernet (IDE)

During this release upgrade, the system will be unavailable to process quotes, orders, tickets and other transactions.
