





# Cisco Webex Teams

## Guest Access to Meetings in Cisco Webex Teams

If you invite people to a meeting in Webex Teams but they don't have a Webex Teams account, don't worry, it's easy to join as a guest. Guests can participate in the meeting but don't have access to the Webex Teams space.

Guest access is available only for Webex team meetings that have a [webex.com](https://www.webex.com) meeting link. Meetings that have a [ciscopark.com](https://www.ciscopark.com) meeting link still require guests to create an account before joining.

You can verify that your meeting has a [webex.com](https://www.webex.com) meeting link:

- Windows, Mac, and Web—Select the activity menu , choose Schedule , and then click **Create manual invite** to see the meeting information.
- iPhone, iPad, and Android—Select the activity menu  and choose **Meetings** .

Guests who join a Webex team meeting from a mobile device are directed to the App Store or Google Play to download the Webex Teams app and create an account.

When guests click the meeting link from a desktop app, they join the meeting by entering their name and email address.

If guests join using Google Chrome or Mozilla Firefox, the Cisco Webex Meetings web app opens.

If guests join using any other browser, the Cisco Webex Meetings desktop app opens, if they already have it. If they don't already have the app, it starts to install.

Guests wait in a virtual meeting lobby until a member of the space lets them into the meeting.
